DOCUMENTS RELATED TO
EXTERIOR OPEN FIRE POLICY

The following resolution has been adopted by the Board of Directors of Sheep Creek Landowners Association at a meeting of the Board to establish a clear policy for exterior open fires within Sheep Creek.

Exterior Open Fire Policy

1. Any outside fire must be contained in a BBQ, fire pit, or fire ring that is 36 inches or less in diameter and at least 10 feet away from any flammable material like bushes and cabins.
2. A spark arrester (such as a screen dome) must be in place whenever there is a fire burning.
3. The fire must be of modest size and never attempted on a windy day.
4. A pail of water and a shovel must be close to the fire.
5. If the Fire Risk in our forests and on our Gate Dial is higher than MODERATE, no fires are allowed.
6. Outside fires must be **completely extinguished** before leaving the area.

*This policy is not intended to encompass a propane fueled fire such as a grill or a free-standing deck fire pit.
