SHEEP CREEK LANDOWNER'S ASSOCIATION DOCUMENTS RELATED TO EXTERIOR OPEN FIRE POLICY

The following resolution has been adopted by the Board of Directors of Sheep Creek Landowners Association at a meeting of the Board to establish a clear policy for exterior open fires within Sheep Creek.

Exterior Open Fire Policy

- 1. Any outside fire must be contained in a BBQ, fire pit, or fire ring that is 36 inches or less in diameter and at least 10 feet away from any flammable material like bushes and cabins.
- 2. A spark arrester (such as a screen dome) must be in place whenever there is a fire burning.
- 3. The fire must be of modest size and never attempted on a windy day.
- 4. A pail of water and a shovel must be close to the fire.
- 5. If the Fire Risk in our forests and on our Gate Dial is higher than MODERATE, no fires are allowed.
- 6. Outside fires must be completely extinguished before leaving the area.

*This policy is not intended to encompass a propane fueled fire such as a grill or a free-standing deck fire pit.
